Your Boxes, Reflection of Your Brand



Blue Line (Safe Area)

The blue line represents the **safe area**, which is 5 mm inside the trim line. When designing your artwork, ensure that **all** important elements, such as text and logos, are within this area. **Any content placed outside this area is at risk of being trimmed! Only background colors or extended background graphics should go beyond this zone.**

Red Line (Trim Line)

The red line indicates the **trim line**, where your artwork will be cut. Ensure that **all** essential design elements are within the safe area to avoid being trimmed off.

Black Line (Bleed Area)

The black line marks the **bleed area**. Any background colors, patterns, or images that extend to the edges of your design should **continue into this zone** to ensure a clean edge after cutting.

IMPORTANT DESIGN GUIDELINES FOR PRINT-READY FILES

- Artwork must be created in the CMYK color mode to ensure accurate color reproduction in print.
- When using black or gray tones, use C: 0 M: 0 Y: 0 K: 100 for deep black. For gray tones, adjust only the K value (e.g., C: 0 M: 0 Y: 0 K: 50 for medium gray).
- Designs must include a bleed margin to prevent unwanted white edges after trimming.
- For high-quality printing, **all** images should be at **least 300 DPI** resolution or vector-based for optimal sharpness.
- For high-quality printing, your design files must be prepared in AI and PDF formats and be vector-based.
